INTRODUCTION

The Hospital

Aligarh is well known for one of the prestigious Eye Hospital in India. Dr. Mohan Lal Memorial Gandhi Eye Hospital as it is known was established in 1928 by Padam Shri Dr. Mohan Lal who has the spirit behind starting the optometry and Orthoptics education in India & situated in the heart of city just walking distance from railway station & Bus Stand. Aligarh is located on main Delhi Howrah Railway line and G.T. Road, it is 130 kms. away from Delhi.

SCHOOL COURSES

Diploma in Optometry

The Course of Diploma in Optometry was started in 1958 at Gandhi Eye Hospital, Aligarh. This is the first school in India for imparting training in Optometry with the affiliation of State Medical Faculty Lucknow.

Optometry embraces the various aspects of optical practice viz. evaluation of the visual status of the eyes including any anomalies present. In last forty years the profession of Optometry throughout the World has made great strides and today an optometrist in the institution works in association with the ophthalmologist. The Curriculum in the world all over includes the diagnosis of ocular ailments. The optometrist should be competent in analyzing the visual problems, investigations and treatment as far as optical correction is required. This includes prescription of glasses of all types, dispensing of contact lenses and analysis of binocular function and visual field chartings etc. The two year course was designed for the students to be efficient in refraction, dispensing of glasses and investigation of ocular ailments.

Diploma in Orthoptics

This Course was started in 1962, Gandhi Eye Hospital has unique distinction of having one of the best equipped orthoptics Department in the country where proper facilities of teaching and training by well qualified staff exist.

The subject of orthoptics deals with the investigations of all aspects of eyes which develop squint or have tendency to deviate with regard to maintenance of normal binocular functions and their management.

Being the main subject of orthoptics, the students are also trained in refraction and introduced to diagnosis and treatment of common eye ailment. Modern life has led to great stress and strain on human eyes which often result in disturbance of binocular functions and it is on this account the orthoptics has gained its importance and its scope is on the rise. First Year Course is common to both the courses. In second year students separate out for specific training in Optometry or Orthoptics.

The Diploma courses in optometry and orthoptics are full time two year courses. The examination for both the courses are conducted by the U.P. State Medical Faculty, Lucknow.

BRIDGE COURSE

This course of one year duration was started in February 2009 by State Medical Faculty, Lucknow, Those student who have passed Diploma in Orthoptics from a recognised institution are eligible for admission after passing student may get two Diploma in three years i.e. Diploma in optometry and Diploma in Orthoptics.

General Information for Admission

1. Admission to both schools are offered through written competitive test.
2. Candidates will be required to apply on the prescribed form obtained from the office of school of Optometry & Orthoptics, Gandhi Eye Hospital, Aligarh on cash payment of Rs. 300/- or may be downloaded from website of Gandhi Eye Hospital trust Aligarh. Website- www.gandhieyehospitalaligarh.in
3. The candidate may obtain the prospectus including admission form from 10th July 2020 till 10th August 2020 during office hours (8.00 AM to 3.00 PM) on cash payment of Rs. 300/-.
4. Application form must be filled by the candidate in his/her own hand writing.
5. Duly filled application form collected from the office will have to be submitted with a demand draft of Rs. 1000/- (Non Refundable) for written test in favour of **Secretary, Gandhi Eye Hospital Trust Aligarh payable at Aligarh.**
6. In case Downloaded duly filled application form will have to be submitted with a demand **draft of Rs. 1300/- (Non Refundable)** for written test and prospectus in favor of **Secretary Gandhi Eye Hospital Trust, Aligarh.**
7. The application form completed in all respects may be submitted by hand in the office of School of Optometry/Orthoptics during office hour (8.00 AM to 3.00 PM) or by **“speed post” “registered A.D.”** post must be sent to the Head of school, School of Optometry and Orthoptics. Gandhi Eye Hospital, Ramghat Road, Aligarh, (U.P.) latest by date 10th August 2020.

No change in the choices shall be entertained after the admission.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

1. Minimum Academic Qualification

The minimum qualification is Intermediate Science with Biology / Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry from U.P. Board or an equivalent recognized examination of any State.

The Candidate who have passed their intermediate or its equivalent examination from any board or university other than U.P, Board are advised to ensure from their respective board/university that their qualification is recognized by the U.P. Board of High School and Intermediate Education, Allahabad (U.P.) as equivalent to intermediate Science of U.P. Board Allahabad. For, Bridge Course the Eligibility will be Diploma in Orthoptics from recognised institution.

The candidates seeking admission in Diploma Courses Optometry / Orthoptics must ensure that they have passed in every subject in intermediate examination and they have not been granted any such grade which is equivalent to fail.

The candidates who are having colour anomalies or only one seeing eye are not eligible for courses.

2. Age Limit

A candidate must not be less than 17 years on 31st December 2020. There is no upper age limit for all the above mentioned three courses. Candidate born after 31-12-2003 are not eligible.

3. Medical Fitness

Candidate should be in good health, mentally sound and should fulfill following criteria of vision.

1. Distant vision with glasses	6/6 Both Eyes/One Eye
2. Near vision with glasses	N ₆ Both Eyes/One Eye
3. Binocular Vision	Desirable

4. Character Certificate

The candidate should have a good moral character. A character certificate from the principal of the institution last attended should be attached with the application form.

5. Intervening Period

If an applicant could not continue his/her study in the preceding session it self he/she should submit an affidavit duly attested by a Notary public. The affidavit must clearly describe the reason in which the intervening period was utilized and it must be submitted along with the application form for admission test.

6. Entrance Test

The candidate will be informed about the Date, Time, Centre and the Roll No. for the entrance test. There will be 100 MCQ (Multiple choice Questions) type in written examination covering Biology, Physics and Chemistry of intermediate standard. The test will be of about 2 hours duration admission will be on the merit basis of marks obtained in Entrance Test for Optometry & Orthoptics. For Bridge Course the admission will be on the basis of marks obtained in Diploma in Orthoptics & Interview.

7. Session

The session of the School of Optometry/ Orthoptics will start from 1st october every year.

8. Other Courses

A selected candidate shall have to give an undertaking in writing immediately before his admission for not joining any other course simultaneously at any other Institution. If a candidate is found to be indulging in such activity his or her name may be struck off from the school without warning & the fees deposited will be forfeited.

9. School Timing

The scheduled time is from 8.30 AM to 2.30 PM subject to the change according to the decision of the Administration of School.

The Time Table for Lectures and Practical work & demonstration will be announced from time to time.

10. Attendance

The attendance at the time of arrival & departure of the Students will be marked through Biometric Attendance Machine Linked with Adhar & directly with state medical faculty Lucknow. If the attendance of the student is not up to the marks as per rule of state medical faculty Lucknow He/She will be directly responsible for their action including to debar from the examination.

11. Practical Work and Demonstration

The students of Optometry & Orthoptics have the opportunity to do the practice in Mechanical optics in the workshop and take demonstrations in refraction and the orthoptics departments. Orthoptics students are also allowed to do refraction and practice in School of Optometry & Orthoptics. Facilities for concerned courses are available at the Gandhi Eye Hospital, Aligarh (U.P.)

12. Clinical Training

Retinoscopy, A-Scan Biometry, Fundoscopy, Slit Lamp, Synoptophore, Perimetry, Keratometry, Pre & Post Care of Patients, Patients Data & Record's, Paediatric Patients Care, Knowledge of Advance equipments, Direct & Indirect ophthalmoscopy, School Screening etc.

13. School Library

Membership will be available to all the students subject to its rules & regulations.

General Discipline

1. The administration reserves the right of erasing the name of any student from the Roll in case of misbehaviour or serious misconduct. These rules may be modified, changed & enforced according to the decision taken by school administration from time to time.
2. Students will not be allowed to carry any type of ammunition, Mobile Phones, Electronic Gadgets, Calculators. If any of these above mentioned things are found with the students that will be seized by the school administration and strict action amounting to restitution and expulsion may be taken against such student.
3. Ragging is strictly prohibited according to Hon'ble Supreme Court Guidelines. Student should not indulge in ragging. If found guilty may lead to his/her restitution / expulsion from school.
4. An affidavit in this regard of the parents / candidate will be taken by school administration at the time of admission.

किसी भी परिस्थिति में अधोलिखित नियमों शर्तों के किसी भी प्रकार से प्रत्यक्ष अथवा अप्रत्यक्ष रूप से अभ्यर्थी के संलग्न पाये जाने पर उसके विरुद्ध सम्बन्धित थाने में एफ०आई०आर० दर्ज करने व उसे प्रशिक्षण कोर्स से तत्काल निष्कासित किये जाने की कार्यवाही की जावेगी जिसका एक

पक्षीय रूप से उत्तरदायित्व अभ्यर्थी एवं उसके परिजनों का होगा।

1. संस्थान में किसी भी छात्र, को रैगिंग, रैगिंग से जुड़ी किसी भी गतिविधि, कनिष्ठ या वरिष्ठ छात्र, छात्राओं को एक दूसरे का उत्पीड़न, टांटिंग, टांटिंग से अभद्र मजाक, बुरी लगने वाली भाषा, व्यवहार, पूर्णतः प्रतिबन्धित है, ऐसी गतिविधियाँ रैगिंग की श्रेणी में मानी जावेगी।

Dress Code :

For Boys

Every student should wear the prescribed dress in the school premises which is as follows :-

- (i) In Summer- Grey Pant, White Shirt
- (ii) In Winter- Grey Pant/White Shirt and Blue Blazer with school prescribed monogram.

For Girls

(iv) Examination fee/Registration fees to be deposited by the eligible candidate him or her self at the time of examination as fixed by the U.P. State Medical Faculty, Lucknow.

Mode of Training:

(a) The course will be for two year as follows:

1st Year: The student will be delivered lectures in General Anatomy, Physiology and Ocular Anatomy with Physiology, Physical, Physiological Optics and Ophthalmic lenses. Besides, they will have to do practical on Neutralization, dispensing of lenses and practice of refraction on model eye in the workshop.

2nd Year : The students will be given theoretical and practical training in the workshops. Orthoptic Department, Out Patients Deptt., Indoor Patients Deptt., Operation Theatre & Various Clinics.

(i) Details of Disease of eye, Investigation and the drugs used in Ophthalmic Practice will be given.

(ii) Mechanical Optics and Ophthalmic Lenses, Manufacturing of lenses, face and frame measuring for optometry students and Bridge courses students orthoptics and pleoptics for orthoptics students.

(iii) Refraction.

(b) Sessional Test: Besides monthly tests, there would be a test before medical faculty examination every year and that would be called pre-state medical faculty test. The students who obtained less marks may be detained on this basis. It is compulsory for the students to put physical attendance in these tests otherwise they will not be allowed to appear in faculty examination.

(c) Elementary knowledge of English Speaking, Reading & Writing classes will be arranged as per the decision of school administration at their convenience.

11. Examinations:

(a) Only such students will be eligible to appear for the final examination to be held in each year who have:

(i) Completed two years training at the school of Optometry / Orthoptics of Gandhi Eye Hospital, Aligarh

(ii) Passed part 1st examination of the State Medical Faculty,

(iii) Cleared all the dues of the school.

(iv) Obtained a certificate of the satisfactory work during their studies at the school and have put in **75% physical attendance in theory and practical work respectively. Attendance shall be of Biometric System. In case of continuous absence from the classes without permission for more than 15 days admission of the candidates is liable to be cancelled. After that neither readmission will be accepted nor any money deposited at the time of admission will be refunded.**

- (v) The students are not allowed to go out of school premises once they have entered the campus and obtained the attendance in class. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against the students who do not attend the classes and monthly test.
- (vi) A candidate who has failed or absent from examination may be allowed subsequent examinations.

Note : There will be a supplementary examination for failed students in February / March every year. The examination fee will be the same as that of the regular examination as fixed by U.P. State Medical Faculty time to time.

The examination are usually held in the month of Aug/Sept. and February / March every year in the 3rd or 4th week. The dates are notified on the school notice board. However, It is the responsibility of the student to find out the date from the office of the School of Optometry / Orthoptics and school does not take upon itself the responsibility for informing the candidates individually.

:(2) Physical and Physiological Optics.

SECOND YEAR ORTHOPTICS :

Theory : 1st Paper : Details of Disease of eye & Nursing Procedures

2nd Paper : Orthoptics and pleoptics

Practical and Viva-Voce : Orthoptics and Pleoptics & Eye Diseases.

SECOND YEAR OPTOMETRY :-

Theory : 1st Paper : Disease of the eye & Nursing Procedures

2nd Paper : Mechanical Optics & Lens & Lens Prescription & Instruments, Drugs and Community Ophthalmology.
